Dear Parishioners ... COVID 19 is now in the **third phase → Road to recovery**. Now all the churches are allowed to be opened. Our church will be opened during day time for private prayers, Eucharistic Adoration and Masses. We all know **one hundred** people are allowed to take part in the services. In the weekend there will be **three Masses: Saturday 6pm, Sunday 7.30am and 9am**. Parishioners are encouraged to take part in the weekend Masses. There will be no Livestream Mass at 10am. The first one **hundred people** that arrive will be allowed to stay for Mass. The rest can try other Masses. If you are unable to attend Mass, or if the church is filled with 100 people, you are dispensed from Sunday Obligation. You can view other Livestream Masses on TV or on YouTube. As you come in, you must sign in your name and phone number per Government Directives. No Holy Water or Bulletins or Hand-shaking yet. No Precious Blood is allowed. No usual collections will be taken but there will be two baskets in the Church foyer for First and Second Collections. Please be generous with your contribution. Our parish needs your support. ## GOSPEL READING

*John 6:51-58*

A reading from the holy Gospel according to John

*My flesh is real food and my blood is real drink.*

Jesus said to the Jews: 'I am the living bread which has come down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I shall give is my flesh, for the life of the world.' Then the Jews started arguing with one another: 'How can this man give us his flesh to eat?' they said. Jesus replied: 'I tell you most solemnly, if you do not eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you will not have life in you. Anyone who does eat my flesh and drink my blood has eternal life, and I shall raise him up on the last day. For my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink. He who eats my flesh and drinks by blood lives in me and I live in him. As I, who am sent by the living Father, myself draw life from the Father, so whoever eats me will draw life from me. This is the bread come down from heaven; not like the bread our ancestors ate: they are dead, but anyone who eats this bread will live forever.'
