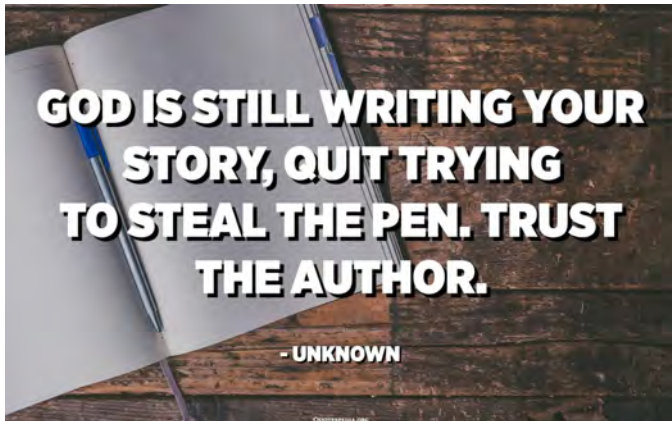
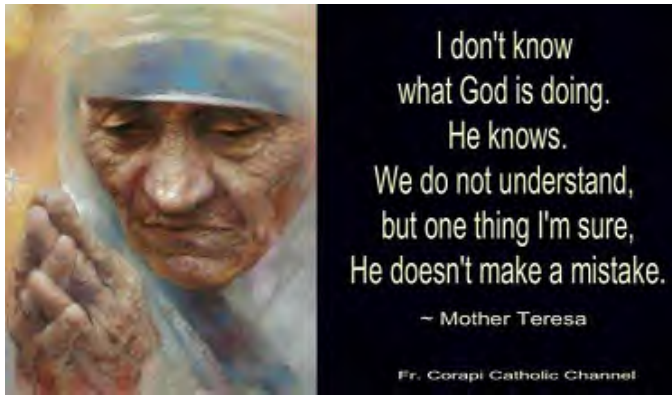
My Jesus, I believe that

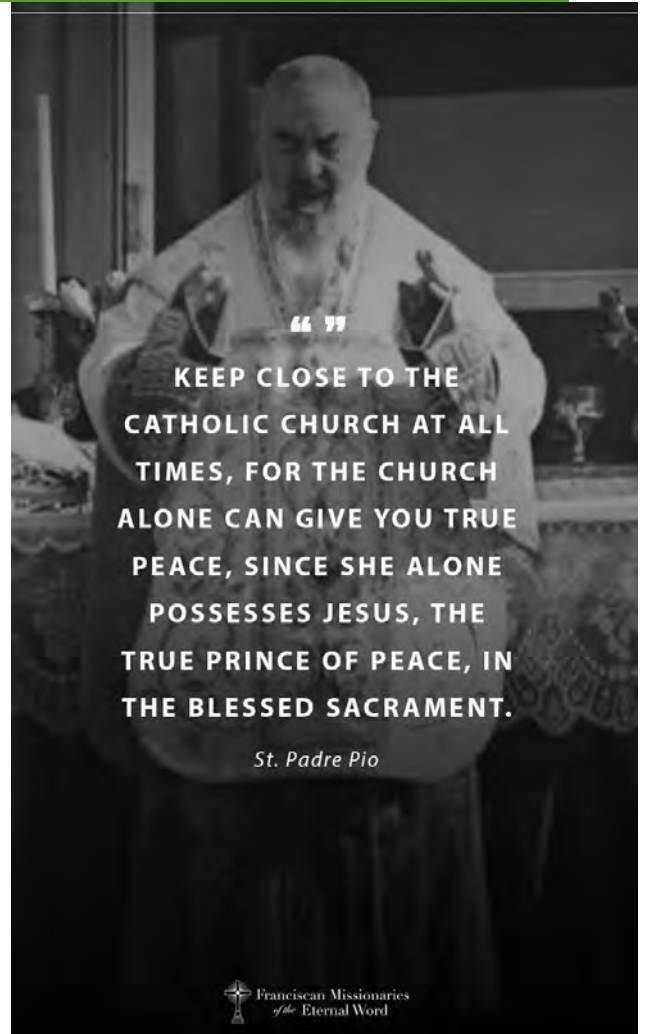

**THE FACE OF THE FATHER** by Thomas W Petrisko: Page 66 – It is our Father's desire that all His children be reunited and that they know, love, and honour Him. Then He will be with us in a truly new way... The ejaculation, "I love you, Father, and I give myself to You." This prayer is a shift from "reparation" to

"restoration"... Page 74 – The mission of Jesus the Son and the Holy Spirit is to restore us to our Father. Because Jesus and the Holy Spirit are God, part of the Holy Trinity, we should also know, love, and honour Them. But we must not neglect our Father, nor should we forget that our only purpose for existing is to return to Him. Page 96 – When our Father uses the term "Remnant" I believe He is referring to those who are in union with Him, in the rhythm and harmony of His will. Page 101 – Our Father's will is like beautiful music. When we are in our Father's will, we are in "sync" with Him; we are immersed in the rhythm and order of it; we are in complimentary harmony... When instruments and voices are out of tune, out of rhythm, and out of harmony, the music is unpleasant because it is discordant. This is what we are like when we are outside God's will.
